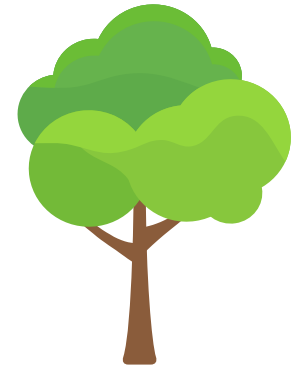

Did you know?

It is estimated 100m of traditional timber hoarding requires 3 x 50ft 40-year old softwood trees just for the hoarding framework. And - for the plywood – a 60ft, fifty-year old fast-growing hardwood tree is needed.

Panthera has teamed up with leading carbon offsetting specialist, Circular Ecology who deliver credible schemes to Gold Standard, Verified Carbon Standard (VCS), Plan Vivo and the UN Clean Development Mechanism. All schemes are retired on official registries and carbon offsetting certificates provided.

So, how does carbon offsetting work when you specify **EnviroHoard™**?

For every linear metre of **EnviroHoard™** installed we will purchase carbon credits from our chosen schemes. Our first being Rimba Raya Biodiversity Reserve and our second being Renewables projects in either wind, solar or hydro.

Rimba Raya is the largest REDD+ project in the world, in terms of avoided emissions delivered to date, protecting nearly 65,000 hectares of peat swamp forest in Central Kalimantan in Indonesian Borneo and avoiding more than 130 million tonnes of carbon emissions.



Rimba Raya is also the world's largest privately-funded orangutan sanctuary.



Rimba Raya develops livelihood programmes in surrounding villages (addressing all 17 of the UN Sustainable Development Goals) to provide education, employment and hope for the future.



Carbon credits will also be bought from credible projects in either wind, solar or small hydro schemes.

Specify **EnviroHoard™** = trees planted, NOT cut down

In addition to supporting our two chosen carbon offset schemes, we will be planting trees in the UK with our chosen UK charity, Trees for Cities. They are the only UK charity working at a national and international scale to improve lives by planting trees in cities - <https://www.treesforcities.org/>

Our partner Circular Ecology will be supporting Eden Reforestation Projects who plant trees across locations such as Madagascar, Haiti, Nepal, Indonesia, and Mozambique. These are all nations that have been ravaged by deforestation - <https://edenprojects.org/>



For each tonne of CO2 offset, Circular Ecology will also plant one tree.



For every 100m of new **EnviroHoard™** installed, Panthera's partner, Trees for Cities will plant three trees across cities in the UK. We will endeavor to coordinate that trees purchased as a result of each project are planted in the community through local programmes, or even on the project itself.

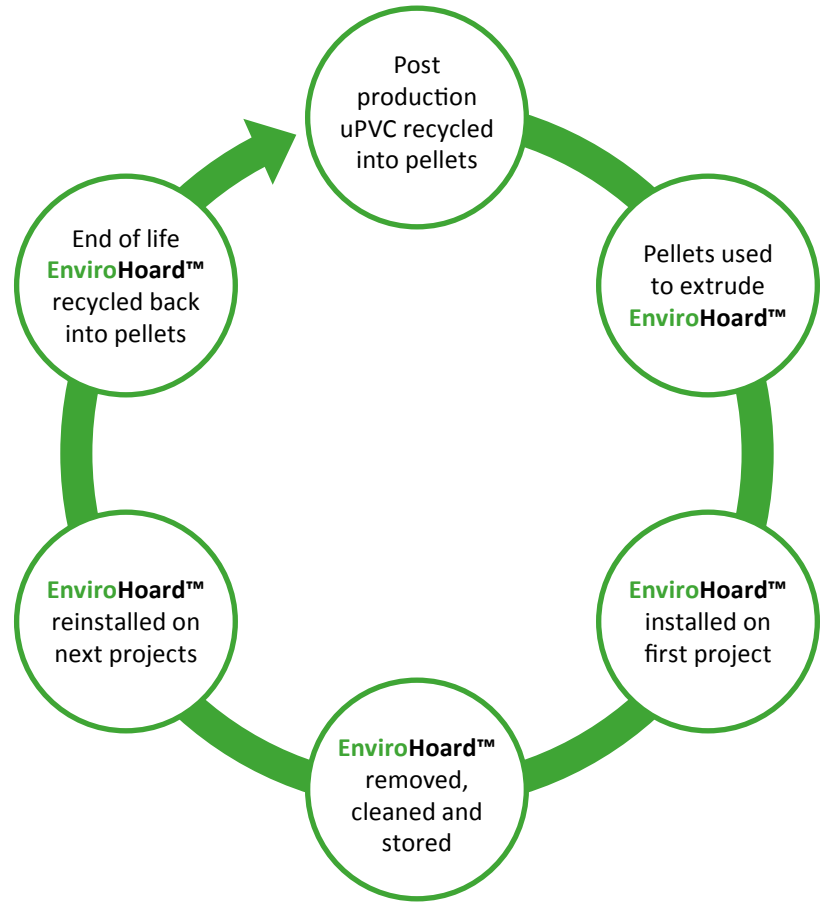
